Company History 1970 – 2010

Founded in 1970 as Triton Engineering (Barrie) Ltd. by Doug Skelton, P. Eng., the company's first offices were located at 54 Maple Avenue in downtown Barrie. In 1971, Denton Brumwell, P. Eng., who had worked with Doug at a construction company in the Toronto area, joined the firm. They knew that Barrie was destined to grow and that



engineering services would be in demand.

In 1974 the company was incorporated as Skelton, Brumwell & Associates Inc. with Doug as President and Denton as Vice President. At the time hand-held calculators were the height of modern technology, and devices like planimeters, flexible curves and "Leroy" lettering were the tools of engineering design and drafting. All communi-

cation was by telephone, letter or in person. The client list grew, and additional staff was hired quickly filling the available office space. An older duplex a block away at 49 Mary Street was purchased and renovated, and the firm moved there in 1977.

While at Mary Street the company grew from a staff of 8 to a maximum of 17 including two additional professional engineers, eight engineering technologists, drafting and field staff and

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three clerical and accounting personnel were required to keep the office running smoothly. In the early years the firm worked in association with Ross Raymond, a local engineer and planner to provide land use planning services. In the 1980's a professional planner and assistant planner became part of the staff.

Despite further renovations and additions to the building, and the eventual relocation of the planning staff to other space nearby, the company outgrew Mary Street and relocated to a brand new office building at 151 Ferris Lane, Barrie, in December 1988. During the boom time of the late 1980's and early 1990's, the staff grew to twenty four people. Most of the design and drafting was being done on computers, PC's were used for word processing and e-mail and the internet emerged as powerful tools for com-



munication and information sharing. Additional expertise was developed to provide services related to environmental management, impact analysis and site assessment.

In 2002, the firm moved to our current location at 93 Bell Farm Road, in Barrie. While many of our staff members are too young to have ever seen a planimeter, one third have been with the firm at least 20 years, and two have been part of the firm for more than 30 years. Similarly, some of our clients have been with us through two or three decades of our history.

We are proud to have been part of the impressive growth and development of the City of Barrie and Simcoe County through the last four decades. We are very proud to carry on Doug and Denton's legacy at a firm that provides high quality service to our clients and is a great place to work!

1980's & 1990's

*Skelton Brumwell has been directly involved in the growth of Barrie through a number of major projects which began in the 1980's and 1990's. In 1982, following the annexation of lands from the Townships of Innisfil and Vespra, we were retained by the **City of Barrie** to prepare Stormwater and Sanitary Master Plans and Policies for the existing and new lands. These Master Plans laid the foundation for the growth that has taken place in Barrie since that time.*

*In 1982 we were part of the design team that started work on the "new" **Royal Victoria Hospital** on Georgian Drive. Eventually this project led to the design and reconstruction of Georgian Drive and redevelopment of the Duckworth/Georgian Drive intersection.*

*Our first project for **Georgian College** began in 1984 and involved the redesign of internal roads on the Barrie Campus. As the College has grown, we have provided services on 45 different projects related both to the maintenance and upgrading of the campus infrastructure and the servicing of many of the new Buildings.*

*Other major clients and projects in the 1980's and 1990's included the development of the **Ontario Provincial Police** headquarters in Orillia and numerous projects for the **Simcoe County District School Board** and the **Simcoe Muskoka Catholic District School Board** on new schools and improvements to existing properties.*

*In addition to these public infrastructure projects, we were retained by **Barrie-View Farms** in 1984 to assist in the development of lands at the northwest corner of Maplevue Drive and Highway 400. This was the beginning of the commercial and industrial development of this area of the City and a great relationship with our client that has continued to the present.*

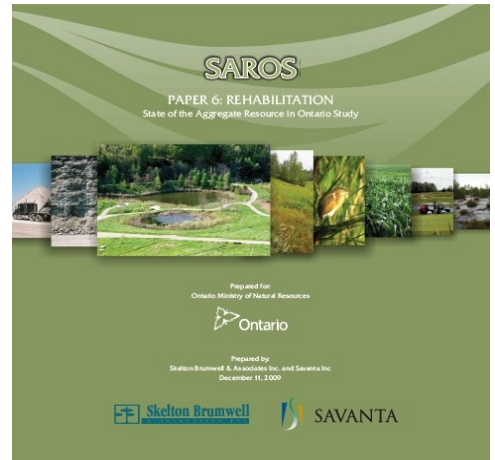


2000's

Skelton, Brumwell has served clients in the aggregate industry since the early days of the Pits and Quarries Control Act. Since then we have been designing site plans, and guiding clients through Official Plan, Zoning and Licensing applications for new pits and quarries in many areas of southern Ontario. Staff have been involved with many interesting public and Council meetings. We work at committee meetings and on site to cooperatively find common ground that addresses the interests of the public, the environment and the need for aggregate resources. Hand in hand with

the extraction process, we have seen positive changes in the industry's ability to rehabilitate sand, gravel or stone extracted lands. In 2009, partnering with Savanta Inc, we co-authored Paper 6: Rehabilitation, which looked at the status of rehabilitation as part of the **MNR's State of the Aggregate Resources of Ontario Study (SAROS)**. Being part of planning and development for aggregate extraction is challenging yet rewarding with aggregate resources contributing so significantly to our built infrastructure, and the opportunity for creating new land-

scapes and land uses through rehabilitation.
